Street Department

The City of Bolivar Street Department maintains 106 miles of streets within the city limits of Bolivar. Our department also provides several other services.

We have leaf pick-up from October through April each year. Brush is picked up routinely on a weekly basis year round. The Street Department has two clean up months each year in April and October. All items except demolition material and appliances containing freon are picked up at curbside. The Street Department is also responsible for the clean-up of destroyed slum dwellings.

Grass in the downtown area and along city sidewalks is mowed as needed. All streets are asphalted and repaired when in need. The street sweeper runs daily. The Street Department has seven full-time employees.

Sanitation Department

The City of Bolivar Sanitation Department provides door to door curbside garbage pick-up to residents within the city limits once weekly at a cost of \$6.00 per month. We also provide dumpsters for all businesses inside the city limits. The cost of the dumpster depends on the size of the business and the number of times per week it is emptied. The Sanitation Department has seven full-time employees.
