The Bolivar Hardeman County Library was first organized and sponsored by the Tuesday Literary Club in 1954. The first location of the library was a small room over the Hardeman County Bank or Sullivans Printing Office and Supply. It is now office space. Miss Lillas Bills donated her collection of several thousand books.

A year later the library was moved to the third floor of the County Courthouse and the sponsors were Hardeman County and the City of Bolivar.

In November of 1976, the library moved to its present location on North Washington Street. This move was to a new building with library specifications and funded equally by the County and the City of Bolivar.

In October of 1991 construction of the addition began and was completed in February 1992. 5,400 square feet was added, we now have 11,400 square feet. Services offered are: children's programs, free internet, how to books, magazines, audios, cake pans, videos, children's section and a history room that contains Tennessee History and genealogy material. People from all over the United States have used the history room.

We have much to offer with 54,000 volumes.
